## **Annual LKSOM Women in Medicine and Science Mentoring Award**

This award recognizes and honors a faculty member whose outstanding efforts and achievements have promoted the professional success and/or overall quality of life of women at the Lewis Katz School of Medicine at Temple University. All LKSOM faculty in any faculty track (Tenure, Clinician-Educator, Educator, Research), in any department, and of any rank are eligible for nomination. Emeritus faculty are also eligible for nomination. The nomination should come from a peer or ideally a mentee (not someone in a supervisory role).

The LKSOM Committee on the Status of Women Faculty will review the nominations and select the award winner. The award will be presented during the Women in Medicine and Science Workshop on Friday, May 13, 2022 and will be announced to the entire LKSOM community. Please send the completed nomination packet to Pat Pileggi (patricia.pileggi@temple.edu) no later than Monday, April 11, 2022.

## A nomination packet should consist of the following:

- 1. A nominating letter <u>or</u> brief video (<5 minutes) detailing the mentoring efforts and relevant accomplishments of the nominee
- 2. A **maximum** of 1 additional letter of support
- 3. A copy of the candidate's curriculum vitae (can follow material above)
