Please summarize your abstract in a one-page narrative consisting of (1) Introduction, (2) Methods, (3) Results, and (4) Conclusion. Please also include the title, authors, and location of the study. The abstract should be no more than 400 words in length.

**Poster Display Instructions:**

1. Put your poster up on Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup> starting at 7:00 a.m. in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor Commons outside Luo Auditorium in the Medical Education and Research Building.
2. Your poster must correspond to the title and content of the abstract you submitted.
3. Your poster should be a maximum of 36" x 48" in dimension and in a "landscape" layout.
4. Plan your poster to be in logical sequence, i.e. introduction, study design and methods, data collected, conclusion.
5. Please list the title, authors, and study location clearly.
6. To ensure visual effectiveness of your poster: use large lettering, maximum imaging, and a minimum of text.
7. Use of color can visually enhance your poster.
8. Remove your poster immediately at the end of the symposium at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup>.
